Kenilworth has always been a village centered around family and community. When Joseph Sears purchased the land for Kenilworth in 1889, he planned the village so that not only would it be beautiful, but it would also be a place with a sense of community.

The Kenilworth Park District offers tee-ball and football leagues for kids, along with a sports program.

**Schools.** Primary school students of Kenilworth attend the Joseph Sears School, where the students rank in the 98th percentile on standardized tests consistently. Language education starts in second grade, and continues to be part of the curriculum throughout the educational process.

New Trier High School serves the need of the high school students in Kenilworth.

**Transportation.** The Village of Kenilworth is located just east of the Edens Expressway, which has access to other major highway systems in the Chicagoland area. Drive time to the Loop is 29 minutes. A trip to Chicago O'Hare Airport will take 31 minutes, while a trip to Chicago Midway Airport will take 43 minutes.

Rail commuters can board the Union Pacific North line in Kenilworth for a 35-minute trip to the Loop.
